### LESSON 11 EXODUS 6:14-30

1. In vv14-27, to whom is the genealogy limited?
2. In vv16-27, on which family does the genealogy focus?
3. In vv26-27, what seems to be the purpose of this genealogy? In general, what is the purpose of genealogies? What do they tell us about Jewish history and its' recordation?
4. In vv16-20, three men are highlighted by commentary. Who are they and how are they highlighted? Is there anything significant in the commentary?
5. Korah is mentioned in v21 and v24. What is his significance in Num 16?

6. If you have a concordance or electronic search, what is the significance of Nashon, v23, Aaron's brother-in-law?
  
7. Assuming in v20 that Jochebed is indeed Amram's aunt, how is that looked upon in the law? See Lev 7:12. What does that possibly tell us about the law vs. custom or practice?
  
8. Vv 28-30 almost treat vv14-27 as a parenthesis. V28 picks up where v13 left off while vv26-27 provide the transition from the genealogy back to the subject. What is the impact of these transitional verses as regards Moses in particular?
  
9. What do vv28 and 29 emphasize again and what does v30 emphasize again?

10. Is family lineage (or should it be) as important to Christians as to Jews in the Bible? Why or why not?
