

## EXODUS BIBLE STUDY AND GUIDE

### LESSON 14 EXODUS 8:16-32

1. In Ex 8:16, what is the command from Jehovah and to whom?
  - The account of this wonder is different from the previous two. It also is the beginning of a pattern in the accounting of each third wonder, i.e., the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, and 9<sup>th</sup>. What seems to be missing?
  
2. In v17, what is the result and to what extent?
  
3. V18 details another change. What is the difference with the magicians?
  
4. To what conclusion do the magicians come, in v19?
  - In light of question 1, what does this account possibly tell us about the presentation of the wonder?
  
  - Do the magicians now believe?
  
  - How is Pharaoh affected?
  
5. The introduction of the account of the 4<sup>th</sup> wonder is very similar to the introduction of the 1st? What happens in v20?
  
6. What will God do and to what extent in v21?

7. What is the stated change that Jehovah declares in vv22-23 and for what purpose and when?
  
8. V24 gives the account of the execution of Jehovah's promise. What is the result?
  
9. In v25, we see the impact upon Pharaoh. Vv25-29 tells of the interaction between Pharaoh and Moses.
  - How does Pharaoh relent and how much?
  - How does Moses respond to Pharaoh's command?
  - What is Pharaoh's response and what does it say about his acceptance of Moses appeal/assertion?
  - What is Moses' response to this?
  - What do we start to see about Moses' understanding of Pharaoh's character?
  
10. We have just seen Moses' suspicion of Pharaoh's character. How does Moses follow up to what he had promised? What did Jehovah do?
  
11. What do we see repeated about Pharaoh?
  - What does this possibly say about how Pharaoh sees Moses and Jehovah?

12. We continue to see the consequences of Pharaoh's hardness of heart. Is it fair that Jehovah takes this out upon the Egyptian people?
