LESSON 16 EXODUS 9:13-35

We have an account of the seventh wonder in this passage.

- 1. The scripture repeats the formula in v13 but in Ex 9:14-16, Jehovah gives further reasoning as to what He is doing. In v14, what will Jehovah do?
 - What is the significance of his heart?
 - Why will Jehovah do this?
 - Most translations seem to put v15 as a lead in to v16 rather than a repetition of v14. In v16, why would Jehovah delay punishing Egypt to the full?
 - What is the indictment against Pharaoh in Ex 9:17?
 - How does Paul use Ex 9:16 in Rom 9:17 to forward his argument for sovereign election?
 - How does Ex 9:17 and Rom 9:18 help us to understand hardening or vice versa?
- 2. What is the plague that God will send in Ex 9:18?
- 3. In vv19-21, what is the gracious warning that Jehovah sends to the Egyptians and what are the two different responses?

- 4. Vv22-26 give the command, execution, and limitation of the command?
 - In case you missed it, what in part made this hail so grievous as described in v19?
- 5. What is Pharaoh's response in vv27,28?
- 6. Moses responds positively to Pharaoh's request in vv29,30, but what is the contrast between what Pharaoh should see from this as opposed to how Pharaoh will respond? Relate this to life experience.
- 7. Vv31,32 give us a limitation to the destruction and may give us a time clue. What is it?
- 8. Vv33-35 give us a confirmation of what Jehovah had spoken through Moses. Describe the response from Pharaoh and what is emphasized?
