## LESSON 18 EXODUS 10:21-11:10

- 1. What is the pattern for the ninth wonder or plague? What is the nature and extent of the wonder in vv21-23?
  - How were the people of Israel impacted?
- 2. In v24, what is Pharaoh's response and what does it say to his thinking?
- 3. In vv25-27, what is Moses' response?

- 4. How is the hardness of Pharaoh's heart displayed in vv27-28?
- 5. In v29, how does Moses respond?
- 6. When does Ex 11:1-10 take place?
- 7. In vv1-3 as Jehovah begins to introduce the tenth plague, what is the relationship of vv1&3 to v2?
  - What do you think that Jehovah wants Moses to understand?

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- What do you think that Jehovah wants the people of Israel to understand?
- 8. Vv4-7 describe in more detail the tenth plague and describe some of the things that accompany it.
  - To whom is Moses speaking?
  - What is the plague and to what extent?
  - How is the distinction described between the people of Egypt and Israel?
- 9. How does v8a perhaps relate to vv1-3?
- 10. Vv9-10 may summarize again the continued hardness of Pharaoh along with the sovereignty of God. What is that summary?
