

EXODUS BIBLE STUDY AND GUIDE

LESSON 29 EXODUS 16:13-36

This passage details the giving of the meat and bread that He promised. However, the account of the giving of the meat is less than a verse. The rest of the chapter is spent on the bread. What is it? How do the Israelites receive it and collect it? What are the commands that Jehovah gives and how do the Israelites respond? It is almost as though this passage is in part, at least, the answer to 16:4,5.

1. How is God's promise about the meat fulfilled in 16:13?

2. How is the giving of the bread described in vv13-14? What is the further description in v31?

3. What was the reaction of the children of Israel in v15?

4. What is the first regulation concerning the manna in v16, corresponding to v4?

5. Vv 17-18, 21 describe Israel's obedience and v 20 the disobedience. Describe Israel's obedience, from vv17-18, 21.
 - What was the additional instruction/command in v19?

 - V20 answers in part to the test in v4. What was the disobedience in v20 and what was the result and Moses' response?

6. Vv22-30 respond in part to v5 in instructions and obedience and v4 to the testing. What is the obedience and response in v22?
 - What is Moses' response in v23 and result in v24?

- What is the repetition and further instructions in vv25-26?
 - What is the disobedience in v27?
 - What is the LORD's response and reinforcement in vv28-29?
 - Other than the manna, what is the emphasis in this passage, vv22-30?
7. What is the LORD emphasizing in vv33-35 and how does He do it?
- What seems to be miraculous?
 - Does anything seem to be out of place/time in this passage? If so, what?

CONTEMPLATION

8. As you have studied this passage, what are some of the questions or lessons that have been impressed upon you?
9. Look at John 6, particularly vv31-58. How does the Lord Jesus use this passage (in Exodus 16) to reveal truth concerning Himself and what is that truth?
