 - Who was probably the oldest sibling? Ex 2:7
 - What was the difference in Age between Moses and Aaron? Ex 7:7
- 3. Concerning v2, how do Acts 7:20 and Heb 11:23 differ yet complement each other?
 - Acts 7:20
 - Heb 11:23
- 4. How do all of the above verses (#3) speak to the mindset of the mother in vv3-7?
 - V3
 - Vv4,7
- 5. What do vv6-10 say concerning:
 - Pharaoh's daughter?
 - Human nature as exhibited by Pharaoh's daughter?
 - Perhaps along with Ex 1;18, 22, the obedience to Pharaoh's order?
 - The irony of Pharaoh's fear to Pharaoh's daughter's action and what will yet occur?
