

EXODUS BIBLE STUDY AND GUIDE

LESSON 41 EXODUS 25:1-22

In Exodus 24, the covenant is sealed and God's acceptance of the people confirmed. Moses is then called back to the summit to receive the tablets as a memorial and other laws and commandments.

Chapters 25-31 detail the pattern of the tabernacle sanctuary (and its servants) which will symbolize, represent and house the presence of God among His people.

1. In vv1-2, what is the nature of the collection of the materials needed? From where did they come?
 - What are the contributions in vv3-7?
 - What is the purpose in v8?
 - What does v9 say about the design? How is this used in Hebrews 8:1-8?

2. In vv10-22, what is the combination piece of furniture?
 - What are their purposes, from vv21-22?
 - Describe some of the details of each from vv10-20.
