LESSON 5 EXODUS 3:1-10

1. What is the name of Moses' father-in-law? See also Ex 2:18, Nu 10:29, Ex 4:18.
2. In v1, where was Moses and what was he doing? See also Acts 7:30, 35.
3. What drew Moses' attention and who appeared to him, from where, in v2,3? What did Moses see?
4. Who calls out to Moses and from where in v4? See also Acts 7:31.
 - Are the personalities in v2 and v4 the same? Why or why not?
 - What is a theophany and how does that apply here?
5. In v5, what did God require Moses to do?
 - Where was Moses in a physical sense?
 - What was being impressed upon Moses?
6. What was Moses' response to God's identification of himself? What changed between v3 and v6?
7. In vv7-10, God indicates His full engagement with the children of Israel.
 - What are the terms that He uses in vv7,8?

- He repeats these somewhat in vv9,10. How does he use this repetition to clarify what He will do?
- What is the deliverance?
- What do the use of these terms really indicate about God's engagement with the people of Israel?
