## The Good News of Forgiveness

This week, we will consider forgiveness of others as a lens to learn more about God's forgiveness of us!Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.-Psalm 32:1Why is it hard to ask for forgiveness?

How can we overcome some of these barriers?

Read Psalm 32.

What observations can you make?

- 1. I will find joy in forgiveness! (Psalm 32:1)
- 2. I am deep in <u>deceit</u> when I try to <u>conceal</u> sin (Psalm 32:2)
- 3. <u>Unconfessed</u> sin will <u>weigh</u> us down (Psalm 32:3-4)
- 4. I must <u>own</u> my sin rather than <u>covering</u> it (Psalm 32:5)

What does godly sorrow look like?

- 1. <u>Brokenness</u> over sin (Psalm 51:17)
- 2. <u>Softening</u> the heart (Ephesians 4:17-19)
- 3. Produces <u>repentance</u> (2 Corinthians 7:10)
- 4. Running <u>to</u> God, not <u>from</u> God

Read Genesis 33:1-11.

What observations can you make?

- 1. I may face great emotions (Genesis 32:3-8)
- 2. I must humble myself before God (Genesis 32:10)
- 3. I must spend time in prayer (Genesis 32:10-12)
- 4. I must trust God's promises (Genesis 32:12)
- 5. I must <u>humble</u> myself before the offended (Genesis 33:3)
- 6. There is great <u>relief</u> in reconciliation (Genesis 33:4)
- 7. We are not <u>designed</u> for <u>division</u>!
