

EXODUS BIBLE STUDY AND GUIDE

LESSON 44 EXODUS 27:1-21

In Exodus 24, the covenant is sealed and God's acceptance of the people confirmed. Moses is then called back to the summit to receive the tablets as a memorial and other laws and commandments.

Chapters 25-31 detail the pattern of the tabernacle sanctuary (and its servants) which will symbolize, represent and house the presence of God among His people. Chapter 27:1-21 is mainly concerned with two parts, the altar and the outer court, and the oil for the lampstand back in chapter 25.

1. In v1, what are the dimensions of the altar?

2. In vv2-8, what is the character of the structure?
 - What parts seem clear and which do not without a model, considering v8?

 - What are some of the accessories and of what material are they made?

3. Vv9-19 describe the court of the tabernacle.
 - What are the dimensions of the court?

 - How are the north and south side constructed, layout and materials?

 - How does the layout differ on the west side and the east side, layout and materials?
