LESSON 47 EXODUS 30:1-38

In Exodus 24, the covenant is sealed and God's acceptance of the people confirmed. Moses is then called back to the summit to receive the tablets as a memorial and other laws and commandments.

Chapters 25-31 detail the pattern of the tabernacle sanctuary (and its servants) which will symbolize, represent and house the presence of God among His people. Chapter 30 describes the last pieces of furniture, probably the resources for the future care of the tabernacle, and the composition of the anointing oil and incense.
