EXODUS BIBLE STUDY AND GUIDE

LESSON 53 EXODUS 34:1-9

In the latter half of Exodus 33, Moses had begun to further intercede for the people. Although Jehovah had relented from destroying the people and commanded them to go forward, the alienation was plain. Moses sought assurances from Jehovah based upon His established relationship with Moses, that Jehovah's relationship with His people would be restored. This would be demonstrated by God's presence among His people as they went. Even as Jehovah assures him, Moses presses even more for Jehovah to reveal His glory, i.e., His person and character, perhaps as the basis upon which the assurances will be carried out.

Chapter 34 is the continuation and answer to Moses' request.
