LESSON 56 EXODUS 35:4-36:1

Exodus 35:4-36:1 perhaps pre-supposes that Moses has given the people information concerning the tabernacle, the place of God's dwelling among His people. This seems to have been part of the end result of Moses' intercession for the people. Also, this may have been a further part of the subject of Moses' conversations with the people in Ex 34:29-35.

Nevertheless, chapter 35 represents a general fulfillment of Ex 25:1-7 and Ex 31:1-11.

 - What is the command and the attitude or specific audience enjoined in v5?

 - What are the materials in vv5-9?

2. What is addressed in vv10-19?
 - Who is the targeted audience in v10?

 - What is the order of the items addressed in vv11-19?

 - What is added to the original description in v18?

3. Vv20-29 describe the response of the people of Israel.
 - What is the effect of the narrative in vv20-21? There may be at least two ways to look at this.

 - Vv22-29 build upon the general statement in v21. Who are the specific groups of people identified that fill out the general statement?
