## EXODUS BIBLE STUDY AND GUIDE

## **LESSON 57 EXODUS 36:2-7**

After the identification of the appointed leaders of the work, vv2-7 give the account of the calling of the workmen. The particular focus however is the level of contributions from the people as the workers begin to accomplish the task.

In this lesson, we will not only look at the above verses but also at several other instances of giving in the scriptures. Please keep in mind that these passages are not exhaustive nor constitute a whole theology of giving towards the work of God. However, they may give some food for thought, meditation and prayer.

1.	How does v2 follow up Moses' assertions in 35:30 -36:1? What else may be hinted in v2?
2.	What is the subsequent task in v3a and what may be implied? What is stated in 3b and what does it imply?
3.	In vv4-5, what is the result, what specificity, and the implications? .
4.	How does Moses respond in v6?
5.	What is the consequence in v7?

6.	Look at the following passages: 1 Chron 22, 28:11-29:19, 2 Chron:2. What are the similarities and differences particularly as related to giving for the temple as opposed to the tabernacle?
7.	Read Ezra 1, 2:68-70, 6:1-5. What are the similarities and differences particularly as related to giving for the second temple as opposed to the tabernacle?
8.	Read Acts 2:42-47, 4:32-37. What was the immediate focus upon giving in these verses as opposed to the previous examples? (You may also want to read 1Cor 8-9.)
9.	What are some lessons that you can take from the Exodus passage as well as the others?
