LESSON 58 EXODUS 36:8-38:31

This passage gives the narrative of the construction of the tabernacle. Most of Exodus 36:8-38:20 repeats much of the descriptive information about the dimensions of the tabernacle and its' individual components. The main difference is "he made" rather than "you shall make." The priestly garments will be in chapter 39.

Exodus 38:21-31 give a recording or mini-summary and tally of the gold, silver and bronze used in the construction.

•	What is the most repeated phrase in this section and what is the significance? See vv22 (particularly) and 23.
2.	What is the summary in v21? What is significant about the description of the tabernacle?
•	What information is added and what is or may be significant concerning it?
3.	According to v23, how much gold was used?
4.	According to vv24-26, how much silver was used and, using a commentary, what might be the significance of the amount?

5.	What is the breakdown of the silver use in vv27,28?
6.	In vv29-31, what is amount of bronze used and for what purposes?
7.	While this section is mainly recording information, what are some lessons or insights that you might see in this passage?
