## EXODUS BIBLE STUDY AND GUIDE

## **LESSON 60 EXODUS 40:1-38**

With all of the components having been completed and approved, Jehovah gives instructions to Moses (vv1-15) concerning the setting up of the tabernacle. This includes the first date it is to be set up and the order in which the setup is to occur.

Vv16-32 describe the setup. The remaining verses lay out the acceptance by Jehovah of the tabernacle, fulfilling its purpose, and how the symbol(s) of His presence will be instrumental in conducting the people through the wilderness journey.

3.	What is the main subject of vv9-16? How is this section divided and how does that impact the purpose statements?'
4.	How is v16 used?
5. •	Examine vv17-33 then compare to vv2-15. How are the sections ordered and divided? How many sections are there?
•	Are there any differences in emphasis of the two passages, vv17-33 to vv2-15?

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•	Are there any significant differences, i.e., do you see something missing, in vv17-33 and if so, what?
•	For extra credit, where can the missing part be found?
•	In vvvv17-33 culminating in v33b, who did the work? Be prepared to defend your answer.
6.	How is Jehovah's acceptance displayed in v34?
7.	What is displayed in v35? Relate this to Exodus 33:17-23.
8.	What is described in vv36-38 and what is the point (maybe more than one)?
9.	What are some lessons for you from this chapter?
